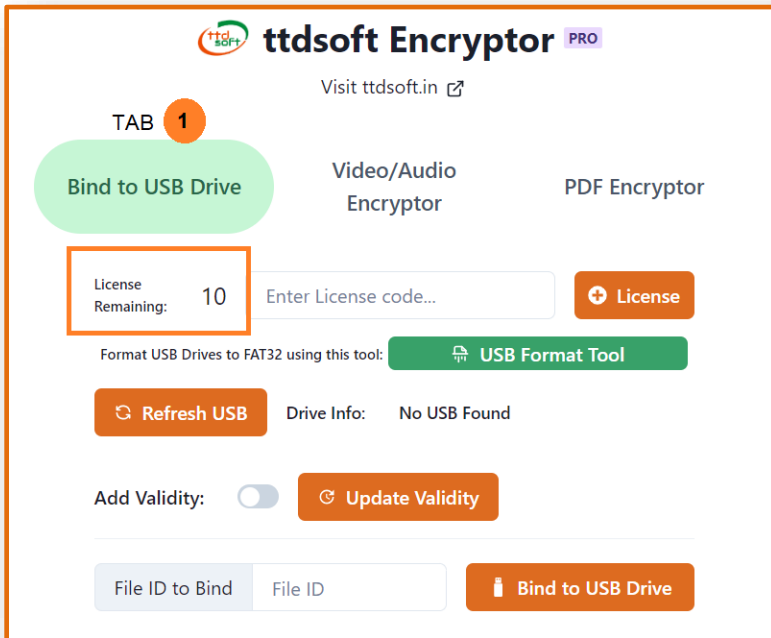
Step 6 - Do Bind to USB Drive for encryption.

6-1. Now click on icon, ttdsoft encryptor

If software is asking for secret code, put same secret code “ttdsoft-ts” and click on save secret code

Or

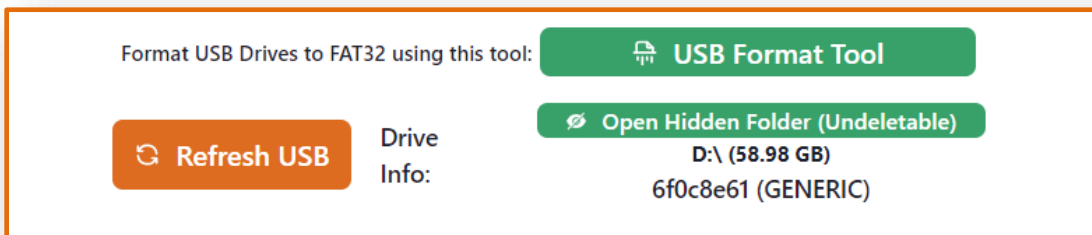
go to **Tab-1** Bind to USB Drive, with Full – License Mode [10 no's]



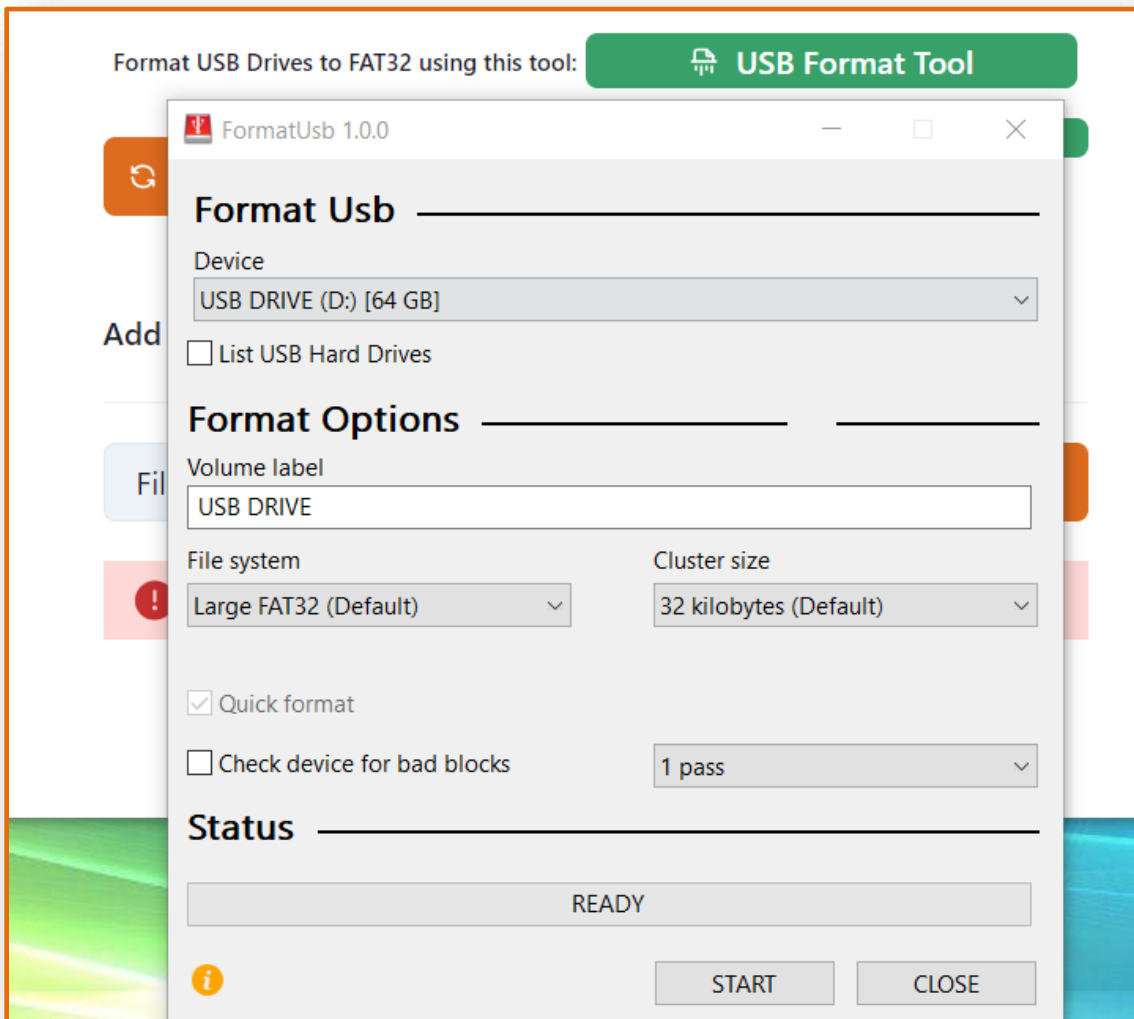
6-2. Put your USB Drive and click the “Refresh USB” button.

All information about your USB drive will appear

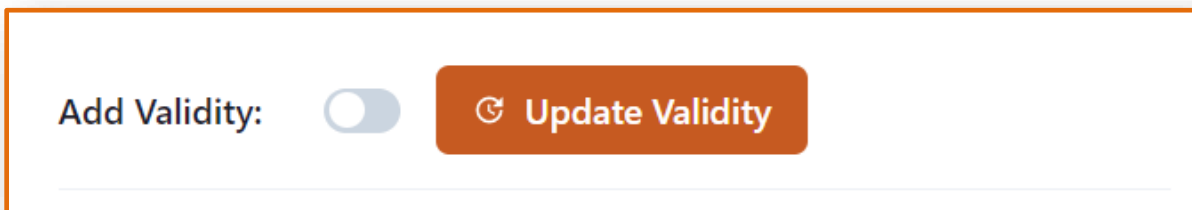
1. Drive letter E,F,G or D.
2. Size of USB Drive.
3. Hardware serial no. of USB Drive.
4. USB Drive is generic or branded.



6-3. Now, format the USB Drive with the format tool to click Button " USB Format Tool ".



6-4. Add validity of USB Drive for encrypted files now or can be added later also.



6-5. Here In Paid Mode [Full license Mode] ,we will put same file(s)-ID which we used for encryption for video, audio and PDF files, that is “ts”

Now, click on Bind to USB Drive - license file will be written on USB Drive.

Note – Now Licenses are reduced from 10 nos to 9 nos

Note - Your USB Drive is encrypted with Secret Code [ttdsoft-ts] and Files-ID [ts].
